The Alabama State Treasurer's Office is proud to offer the *CollegeCounts Scholarship* for high school seniors planning to attend Alabama colleges and universities in Fall 2023. Over the last ten years this Program has awarded \$9.3 million to more than 2,700 Alabama students!

The *CollegeCounts Scholarship* is a **needs-based scholarship** designed to help more Alabama students get started in college. Details of the Program:

- Must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 and maximum ACT score of 26 to apply
- Awards of \$4,000 for four-year college enrollees and \$2,000 for two-year college enrollees
- Non-renewable award granted on a semester basis
- Funds to be used for tuition, fees, books, room & board (if enrolled at least half-time and billed through the school), supplies & equipment required for enrollment
- Scholarships determined through an application process
- Up to two awards per county are possible (dependent on applications from each county)
- This year's application period opened on December 1, 2022 and will close on February 28, 2023.
